# **REGULATIONS**

The following Technical Regulations are specific for the ProVelo Super League (PSL). These should be read in conjunction with the AusCycling / UCI Road and General Regulation and specific event Technical Regulations.

## **1. REGISTRATION**

- 1.1 All Australian riders must hold a current AusCycling racing membership. International riders must hold a current UCI License and international insurance
- 1.2 All PSL registered riders and team personnel must have successfully completed the Sport Integrity Australia Anti-Doping Annual Update Course.
- 1.3 All riders must be eligible to race in the under-17 category (riders aged 15 – 16 on 31 December of the competition year)
- 1.4 Riders are permitted to wear any cycling branded clothing they wish.
- 1.5 Following each PSL event, the league leader will be presented the PSL leaders jersey. This jersey must be worn in the subsequent event.
- 1.6 All registered riders will be registered as individuals only. No teams entries will be accepted
- 1.7 All riders must comply with the AusCycling regulations regarding gearing restrictions of a maximum roll out of 7 meters

## **2. TIME TRIAL EQUIPMENT**

- 2.1 ONLY road bikes will be permitted in PSL events, no time trial bikes
- 2.2 All road bikes MUST meet the UCI rules for mass start events. (ie- no aero/tt bars, no disc wheels, etc)
- 2.3 Time Trial style helmets and shoe covers will be permitted.
- 2.4 Helmet must have an Australian standards sticker or international equivalent to the Australian/New Zealand Standard 2063: · NSI Z90.4 · Snell "B" or "N" series · ASTM F1447 · Canadian CAN/CSAD113.2M · U.S. CPSC standard for bicycle helmets · European CEN standard for bicycle helmets (EN1078)

- 2.5 Helmet must be no longer than 450mm in length, no wider than 300mm and no higher than 210mm from top to bottom.

### 3. RACE RADIOS

- 3.1 Race radios are not permitted in all PSL17 events

### 4. PSL17's SERIES POINTS

#### 4.1 Overall Individual Classification

At each PSL17 event, all riders score PSL points based on their placing in the classifications listed below.

1. Final overall general classification in tours

Place	1	2	3	4	5	6	7	8	9	10	11	12	13	14	15	16-25	26-50	51+
Points	100	80	68	58	49	42	36	31	26	22	19	16	14	12	10	5	3	1

2. Individual stage placings in tours

Place	1	2	3	4	5
Points	18	14	12	10	8

The points scored through these 2 channels are added up across all three rounds of the PSL17's. The rider with the most points after the last round is the PSL17's Overall Champion.

### 5. BRAKING TIES

In the case that two riders or more have the same total number of points, ties are broken using the following criteria:

1. Rider with the highest total number of points scored in the overall general classification across all rounds
2. Rider with the highest total number of points scored in stage classifications in tours

## 6. LEADERS JERSEYS

- 6.1 The overall PSL17's leaders will be presented with the PSL leaders jerseys at the conclusion of each round. They must wear that leaders' jersey in every round where they are leading
